Dear Parents,

This week we will be

- Learning the ch and sh and practising the tricky words my, was and you.
- We will be segmenting for spelling, attempting to write such words as fish, cash, bash, rush, much, such and check. You can always practice these words at home to support the learning that is happening at school.
- We will be reading one of our favourite books, 'Peace at Last' and discussing all of the animals that sleep during the day and are awake during the night. We will be learning the terms 'nocturnal' and 'diurnal.'
- We will be writing speech bubbles for the different animals in the story and thinking carefully about the sounds they make and how we can replicate these sounds ourselves.
- We will be using Numicon to help us create our own number lines and will be hiding the shapes so that our learning partners can act as number detectives.
- We will be learning how to form the number 10 and will be practising careful counting.
- In PHSE, we will begin to talk about families and how different families can look quite unlike our own.
- In RE we are learning the story of 'The Nativity' and talking about Jesus' birth and how Christians celebrate this special time
