This week we will be ....

- Learning the **ar, or and igh** sounds and practising all of the tricky and high frequency words that we have learnt so far (do have a practice of **and, to, the, I, no, go, into, was, we, me, he, she, be, my, you, her, this, that, then, they, they** if you can)
- We will be segmenting for spelling, attempting to write such words as **car, cart, hard, market, for, fork, cord, high, sigh, light**. You can always practice these words at home to support the learning that is happening at school.
- Learning the new tricky words **my, for and too**.
- Talking and writing about our Christmas holiday.
- Starting our new topic! It is called 'Off We Go!' (please see the separate topic letter also glued into this homework book).
- Reading the story of the Naughty Bus and thinking about the wonderful journey he goes on.
- Visiting our school library and doing some topic investigation.
- Making our own number sentences involving adding two quantities.
- We will be looking at the number 14 and playing some number games
- Learning about how Christians can help each other.
- Learning about how we can stand up for ourselves when we are not happy about how we are being treated.
