To keep costs down, we are asking for parents to drop off at Wakehurst Place for 9:45am and collect at 2:00pm. Current guidance states that car sharing is allowed, but the driver should wear a face covering and windows need to be open to allow for ventilation.

Children will need a water bottle and packed lunch for the day. If you would like a school packed lunch please indicate this on the permission slip. Children should wear their school jumper and shirt but with suitable trousers for spending most of the day outside. They will also need to wear trainers and bring a coat in case it rains.

We have Risk Assessments in place to ensure we are following Covid-19 safety measures. This includes a limit on the number of schools visiting; regular handwashing; equipment being quarantined before use and helpers keeping a recommended distance. If you have any further questions or concerns please do not hesitate to contact me.

The cost of the trip is £7.40 per child for payment via ParentPay and the permission slip needs to be returned to school by **Monday 26th April**.
