As we come to the end of another very eventful year, we would like to let you know the events that we are hoping to hold as a community and how we will ensure these are able to happen as safely as possible.

The whole school Summer Production is being held on **Wednesday 21st July** and we have written separately to you about this, including your tickets for the show time your family has been allocated. Thank you for your understanding in this – we will let you know as soon as possible if we are able to make any changes to this following the government's announcements about further lifting of restrictions.

On **Friday 9th July**, we are hoping to have our Sports Day, which we would love you to join us for. In case of bad weather, the back up date for Sports Day is **Friday 16th July**. The children's races will begin at 2pm on The Croft and this will be followed by the PTFA Summer Social; information about this will be shared via WhatsApp and through fliers in book bags. Similar to our May Fair event, we have written a risk assessment for Sports Day (sent via email) and ask that you please let us know who is hoping to attend the event by filling in the form below and returning it to the School Office by Wednesday 7th July. There will also be a QR code available to scan on arrival and these will both be used for contact tracing if the need arises.

End of year reports will be sent home (via bookbags) on **Friday 16th July**. If you have any questions about the report, please contact the School Office to make an appointment with the class teacher(s). All appointments will be held on **Tuesday 20th July**, after school.

On **Thursday 22nd July** (the last day of the school year), we will be holding the Year 6 Leavers' service in the church at 11:00am. We would usually invite the whole school community to this service as it is also a chance to celebrate the Year 2 children and give them a small gift as they move into Key Stage 2. However, this year, we will only be inviting children in Year 2, Year 3 (as they did not get their bibles last year) and Year 6. If you are a parent of a child in these year groups, we will write to you separately about this. Again, if restrictions are ended in time for us to invite everybody (and in time to make necessary arrangements with the church), we will contact you as soon as we can.
